Tagxedo Instructions:

- Go to www.tagxedo.com
- Select create
- Click on load to enter your word list.
 - You must use at least ten words or phrases to describe your protagonist. One of these items may be his/her name.
 - Enter these words/phrases into the enter text box.
 - Click on submit to load the words into your tagxedo
- Carefully choose a theme (colors) and a shape
 - On the back of your tagxedo add a sentence or two about why you chose the shape
- Click on Save/Share and print the image to turn in

Collage Instructions:

- Cut out letters to form words or full words from old newspapers and magazines to describe the protagonist
- You must use at least ten words and/or phrases for your descriptions. One of these items should be the name of your protagonist.
- You must also include at least one art piece or picture in your collage
- On the back of your collage add a sentence or two about why you chose the picture/image that you added

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Plot Chart Sheet

Plot refers to all the events/action in a given story. There are six parts of plot:

- exposition
- initiating event
- rising action
- climax
- falling action
- resolution

Use the chart below to add in at least ten different events to the plot chart for your story. You must include at least one item for each section (i.e. one event in the exposition and one in the falling action). If you need additional space, you may number the lines/points on the graph and attach a sheet of paper with the complete event description.
